

- Really put the person (user) central
 - User involvement in Assistive technology development & policy
 - Look at individual outcome / Quality of Life
 - Assistive technology as tool for participation & empowerment
- Assistive technology development is just a part of the solution
 - Independent advise, personalisation, training, maintenance, ...
- Transparency & dialogue between users, producers/providers & government. More trust!
 - Rethink financing, rethink market, improve administration, controle
 & follow up
